If the grant request is a technology related request, Mark Fijor (<u>mfijor@d57.org</u>) has been consulted by November 29 <u>prior</u> to submitting to the principal to ensure alignment with the district technology strategy.
- Wellness: encompasses the nutritional, physical and academic well being of District 57 students, as well as addresses student safety inside and outside of schools. If the grant request is a wellness related request, Jason Kaiz (jkaiz@d57.org) has been consulted by November 29 prior to submitting to the principal to ensure alignment with the district.

Discuss the grant with administrative staff by November 29 and the building principal to ensure that what is being requested cannot be funded under the building's budget or the district's budget.

The proposal clearly describes how the project/activity will enhance student learning. Documentation/evaluation strategies are described thoroughly.
